

## **DOCUMENTATION TO BE PRESENTED TO ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS CONCERNING A SPORTING DRIVING LICENCE**

### **ITALIANS**

- Sporting Licence for Competitor/Driver or Driver with a minimum Regularity qualification;
- A health certificate for non-competitive sports (attachment 1) or competitive sports (attachment 2) depending on the licence level held and depending on the age of the interested party;
- Driver's licence;
- ACI membership card.

### **FOREIGNERS**

- Competitive sporting licence of International level and relative health certification for competitive sports according to the foreign competitor's relevant national health service regulations;
- Driver's licence (national and international if necessary)

## **DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A SPORTING LICENCE DIRECTLY ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT ALREADY HOLD ONE**

### **ITALIAN DRIVERS**

#### **1. UNDER 75**

At the time of issuance/renewal of the licence, all applicants must produce the following documents:

- A health certificate for non-competitive sporting activities (as per attachment 1) issued in Italy according to current regulations;
- A driver's licence;
- ACI membership card (for those not up to date with the association, it will be possible to renew/be issued with a card by giving the details of the vehicle used every day or the registration number of the historic vehicle entered into the competition, depending on the type of ACI service required).

#### **2. OVER 75**

At the time of issuance/renewal of the licence, all applicants must produce the following documents:

- health certificate for competitive sporting activities (as per attachment 2), for applicants requesting a navigator's licence, it is sufficient to produce a health certificate for non-competitive sporting activities, issued in Italy according to current regulations;
- Driver's licence;

- ACI membership card (for those not up to date with the association, it will be possible to renew/be issued with a card by giving the details of the vehicle used every day or the registration number of the historic vehicle entered into the competition, depending on the type of ACI service required).

## FOREIGN DRIVERS

### 1. UNDER 75

At the time of issuance/renewal of the licence, all applicants must produce the following documents:

- A health certificate for non-competitive sporting activities (as per attachment 1) issued in Italy according to current regulations; or, alternatively, a medical certificate stating good health, issued abroad, written in English, and signed and stamped by a doctor.
- Self-certification stating that the applicant does not hold other valid licences issued by other NHS and to not be subject to disciplinary sanctions;
- Driver's licence, national and international

### 2. OVER 75

At the time of issuance/renewal of the licence, all applicants must produce the following documents:

- health certificate for competitive sporting activities (ref. attachment 2) issued in Italy according to current regulations; or, alternatively, a medical certificate stating good health, issued abroad, written in English, and signed and stamped by a doctor.
- Driver's licence.

Should it be required, it will be possible to have a specific medical check-up, for a fee, at the check-up facilities, in order to obtain the non-competitive fitness certificate; a competitive fitness certificate (over 75) can be obtained in an agreed medical centre near the Brescia Fairgrounds.

We take this opportunity to remind you which **original** documents you need to bring with you on testing day:

- Valid driver's licence, national and international;
- Identity document;
- Sporting licence from your country or the Italian daily licence;
- Health certificate (see above);
- Valid vehicle insurance;
- Vehicle registration documents;
- Valid FIVA International Identity Card and/or FIA Heritage Certificate and/or CSAI Papers.
