



DEPARTURE FROM BOLOGNA FOR THE FINAL KILOMETRES OF THE 1000 MIGLIA.

AS OF RIGHT NOW THE FAVOURITES ARE MOCERI AND BONETTI

Bologna, 18th May, 2019 – A light rain greeted the cars of the 1000 Miglia 2019, departing at 7:00 am from Bologna towards Brescia. This is the fourth and final leg. Is a decisive day, for the teams and it is forbidden to make mistakes, because today's prize is glory. Today the winners of the thirty-seventh re-enactment of the Freccia Rossa will be announced.

At the moment, Giovanni Moceri and Daniele Bonetti (Team Alfa Romeo) are at the top of the rankings, in a 1928 Alfa Romeo 6C 1500 SS, with 67910 points. In second place the team of Andrea Vesco and Andrea Guerini (Team Villa Trasqua), with an Alfa Romeo 6C 1750 SS Zagato of 1929, with 67296 points and a gap of 614 points. In third place, with 66525 points, Juan Tonconogy and Barbara Ruffini, in a Bugatti Type 40 of 1927.

«The landscape of yesterday's stages was wonderful, we have been lucky even with the weather. Too bad for the traffic congestion in the second part of the race. The places that the race crosses are magical and beautiful. From today I expect to see so much public and we hope that the weather will be better at our arrival in Brescia ». This was Miki Biasion, the two times world rally champion driving a Ferrari 250 MM Spider Vignale.

Today's first part of the leg is going through the city of Modena, which is also hosting the first edition of the Motor Valley Fest, to then proceed towards Reggio Emilia, Langhirano and Parma, where the last race lunch will take place in the charming setting of Palazzo Ducale.

Once the stop-over is finished, the cars will then head towards Busseto, to then leave Emilia Romagna, entering the heart of the Pianura Padana, passing through Cremona, Carpenedolo, Montichiari and Travagliato, before crossing the finish line in Brescia at around 4:00 pm.



In Brescia, the cars will then close the race, after the Time Check at the end of the leg, parading, as tradition, along Viale Venezia, after 1801 kilometres.

The programme will continue with the traditional awards ceremony, which will take place in Piazza Vittoria from 7:00 pm. To close this beautiful 37th re-enactment of the 1000 Miglia, there will be a closing party, “1000 Miglia - The Night”.

“This edition of the 1000 Miglia has also reached its end. We have explored the most precious treasures of Italy, the well-known and the less well-known, in the path of a lengthy tradition. There has been no lack of enthusiasm from the teams nor lack of warmth from those who have awaited and welcomed us. Once again, the race was planned keeping in consideration the values that the 1000 Miglia carries, such as determination, honesty and the spirit of competition, which is always healthy and bestows great excitement” in the words of Alberto Piantoni, Managing Director of 1000 Miglia Srl.

The 37th re-enactment of the 1000 Miglia, the most beautiful race in the world, takes place from Wednesday the 15th to Saturday 18th May 2019. Respecting the tradition that commenced in 1927, the route starts and ends in Brescia, crossing half of Italy in four laps, before and after the turning point in Rome. With its ability to combine tradition, innovation, creativity, elegance and scenic beauty, the 1000 Miglia is a symbol of Italian excellence around the world. Since 2013, the event has been staged by 1000 Miglia Srl, a company fully owned by the Automobile Club of Brescia, which founded it for this purpose in 2012. Chaired by Franco Gussalli Beretta, flanked by deputy chairman Matteo Marzotto and Maurizio Arrivabene and the managing director Alberto Piantoni, 1000 Miglia Srl closed the last balance sheet with a turnover of over 10 million euro.
