





THE 1000 MIGLIA 2019 IN FABRIANO FOR THE RACE BREAK OF THE SECOND LEG LEADING THE RANKING MOCERI AND BONETTI OF ALFA ROMEO

Fabriano, 16th May, 2019 - The 1000 Miglia 2019 has reached Fabriano for the intermezzo of the second leg that goes from Cervia-Milano Marittima to Rome. After lunch at the Loggiato of San Francesco, the teams of the four-wheeled "jewels" of timeless beauty and charm will resume the regularity race towards Perugia, Assisi, Termi and Rieti, before crossing the finish line in Rome at 8:30 pm.

At the top of the provisional ranking, the heads-up continues among the three favorite crews. At the end of the precision test 27 - Mercatino Conca 6, Giovanni Moceri and Daniele Bonetti (Team Alfa Romeo) are currently in first position, on board an Alfa Romeo 6C 1500 SS of 1928, with 17596; in second place the duo Andrea Vesco-Andrea Guerini (Team Villa Trasqua), with an Alfa Romeo 6C 1750 SS Zagato of 1929, with 17514 points; in third place the Bugatti Type 40 of 1927 by Juan Tonconogy and Barbara Ruffini who have so far totaled 16893 points.

As for the Coppa delle Dame, leads the provisional ranking, with 10184 points and the 46th overall placement, the team consisting of Franca Boni and Monica Barziza on a 1949 Lancia Aprilia 1500.

The spring that is arriving late, with temperatures below the seasonal average and with a variable of the sky over the event, has not held back the curiosity and enthusiasm of many women and men, young and old. Several school children lined up along the roads of the route.



The 37th re-enactment of the 1000 Miglia, the most beautiful race in the world, takes place from Wednesday the 15th to Saturday 18th May 2019. Respecting the tradition that commenced in 1927, the route starts and ends in Brescia, crossing half of Italy in four laps, before and after the turning point in Rome. With its ability to combine tradition, innovation, creativity, elegance and scenic beauty, the 1000 Miglia is a symbol of Italian excellence around the world. Since 2013, the event has been staged by 1000 Miglia Srl, a company fully owned by the Automobile Club of Brescia, which founded it for this purpose in 2012. Chaired by Franco Gussalli Beretta, flanked by deputy chairman Matteo Marzotto and Maurizio Arrivabene and the managing director Alberto Piantoni, 1000 Miglia Srl closed the last balance sheet with a turnover of over 10 million euro.
