



THE 1000 MIGLIA 2021 ARRIVED IN BOLOGNA

Tomorrow the final leg and the announcement of the winner

June 18th, 2021 – The Freccia Rossa left Rome this morning, arrived in Bologna after passing through Lazio, Umbria, Tuscany and Emilia Romagna.

The crews crossed the beautiful hills of Chianti, in a hot afternoon.

At the end of the Chianti 10 step, the provisional ranking was still led by Andrea Vesco and Fabio Salvinelli driving the Alfa Romeo 6C 1750 Super Sport 1929 number 43, followed by Gianmario Fontanella and Anna Maria Covelli in a Lancia Lambda Spider Casaro 1927 number 24. In third place, Andrea Luigi Belometti and Gianluca Bergomi with a 1929 Lancia Lambda Spider Casaro number 41.

The 1000 Miglia is a tough race, but the emotion remains the main protagonist, as **Simone Marchioni, co-driver with Albert Wetz of a number 55 1930 Alfa Romeo 6C 1750 Gran Sport**, said: "I can't believe that all this is coming to an end. I'm already looking forward to the next 1000 Miglia because when it gets into your blood you become addicted. People have welcomed us in a great way and after so many hours of driving they are the ones who give us the energy to continue. It's enough to see the enthusiasm in the children's eyes to forget the fatigue of the kilometers we've driven."

The electric cars in the **1000 Miglia Green** are proving to be up to the task, as Alessandro Rosi, driving a Jaguar I-Pace, confirms: "The car is performing well, both for performance and charge life. Compared to more traditional engines, we haven't had any disadvantages."

After the race dinner, held in the beautiful setting of Palazzo Re Enzo, in the heart of medieval Bologna and home to the economic and social activities of the city, the crews can rest for few hours before the fourth and final leg, before returning tomorrow to Brescia.
