Paddock new venue, car transporter Area for unloading/loading cars

To facilitate the proper conduct of the ongoing vaccination campaign, 1000 Miglia Srl has gladly accepted the request of the competent authorities, transferring the customary venue of the Race Paddock that will be set up at the **former Omb plant in via Agostino Chiappa** next to the Sant'Eufemia-Buffalora metro station.

In close proximity, a parking area has been reserved for car transporters and for loading/unloading cars; under no circumstances will it be allowed to park or unload cars in the area in front of the entrance to the Paddock.

HOW TO GET TO THE PADDOCK

By car

→ From the motorway exit Brescia Centro, take Strada Provinciale 11 Tangenziale Sud (South Ring Road).

From Milan take the Brescia / Sant'Eufemia exit, from Venice the Rezzato / Botticino / Castenedolo exit.

By metro

→ Get off at the S. Eufemia stop. Crossing the road, the Paddock will be 100 meters on the right.

How to access the Paddock for accreditations and checks

Below are the indications of the entire process that must be followed by the crews and cars in the race, Support cars and Technical/mechanical assistance.

Paddock entrance and Pass collection:

CAR CREWS IN THE RACE

Mandatory accreditation in person

- All Drivers will receive a Temporary Digital Pass with QR code by email
- With this **Temporary Digital Pass and QR code**, drivers must go to the **Driver Accreditation Point** in Via Agostino Chiappa, Brescia to sign the COVID declaration and have their personal bracelet affixed which must be kept for the entire duration of the event and cannot be given away
- To speed up the process, the COVID declaration can be digitally signed in advance by clicking on the link that will be sent to the email address given during registration; in the absence of digital activation, the declaration can be signed in paper form during the accreditation phase
- The Temporary Digital Pass with QR code and the possession of the bracelet will allow access to the Paddock by car for verification operations
- the personal Driver Pass will be issued, as always, at the end of the sporting checks.

SUPPORT CAR CREWS WITH FULL HOSPITALITY PACKAGE

Mandatory accreditation in person

- In application of the above mentioned prevention provisions the members of **the Support Car crews with full hospitality package will have to personally go to the Paddock to obtain their pass**, according to the procedures communicated previously.

The Pass must be collected at the Driver Accreditation Point.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CREWS AND/OR MECHANICS

Mandatory request for accreditation

- As for Drivers and Support Cars, technical assistance crews and mechanics will not have free access to the Paddock but must be provided with a Pass. each crew member has received 2 Paddock Guest vouchers that require 2 access passess for their team. Online accreditation is required to obtain the Pass and for subsequent access. Accreditation and delivery of the Pass and the bracelet will take place at the Accreditation Centre in via Agostino Chiappa, Brescia.

New times and methods to access the 1000 Miglia Village

The procedures for stamping cars in the 2021 edition must follow the specifications received from the competent authorities: the metal stamp will be affixed at the Paddock as the last step of the technical verification operations while the Verified sticker, mandatory to conclude the verification process, will be affixed at the **Village in Piazza Vittoria**.

To access the Village it will be mandatory to go to the Paddock at the time of convocation and follow the local police escort.

TRANSFER AND ENTRANCE TO THE VILLAGE OF PIAZZA VITTORIA

Only for the cars in the race

- The transfer from the Paddock to the **Village of Piazza Vittoria** requires a line-up of the cars at the Paddock on the basis of the times assigned to each car during the inspection;
Motorcycles of the Local Police will escort groups of 20 cars departing every 35 minutes from 10:00 to 19:00 on Tuesday 15th and from 08:00 to 11:00 on Wednesday 16th June
- The parade of each group of cars will include a moment on the platform in **Piazza Paolo VI** and a brief stop in **Piazza Vittoria**
- For entry to and exit from **Piazza Vittoria**, the cars must keep to the times communicated by the organization; a stop at the Village of about 30 minutes will be allowed
- When the cars pass through the **Village of Piazza Vittoria**, the Verified sticker will be affixed, which is mandatory to complete the verification process
- It will not be allowed to reach the Village independently or to park in the streets and squares of the centre for any reason.

PRICE-GIVING CEREMONY

The 1000 Miglia 2021 prize-giving ceremony will take place on Sunday 19th June 2021 at the Mille Miglia Museum from 7.00 p.m.

Admission to the Award Ceremony, in compliance with the relevant legal provisions, **will be reserved only for the award-winning crews** and the institutions; everyone will be assigned a seat.

The prize-giving ceremony will be broadcast on live streaming on the 1000 Miglia channels.

A dinner at the hotel has been reserved for all crews.

Mandatory booking for the extra guests of the gold and platinum fees

- The 1000 Miglia 2021 Gold and Platinum fees participants can invite to have dinner in their hotel the respective extra guests foreseen by the Supplementary Race Regulations. If you wish to use these invitations, please send an email with the guests' names to participants@1000miglia.it no later than **Wednesday 16th June**.

Mille Miglia Museum: the Mille Miglia Tavern and the Restaurant

In addition to the Street Food Style refreshment points that will be operating at the Paddock, it will also be possible to have lunch and dinner at the Mille Miglia Museum on Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th June.

The Cascina San Zago Restaurant at the Mille Miglia Museum, open from 11:30 to 15:00, will allow a 20% discount to holders of a 1000 Miglia Pass.

The Mille Miglia Tavern, open from 10:00 to 22:00 will offer various à la carte menus for lunch and dinner.

OTHER VENUES IN BRESCIA

→ During the week of the 39th re-enactment of the Red Arrow race, there will be numerous venues throughout the city of Brescia, which has always been the City of the 1000 Miglia.

COVID-19 2021 Guidelines

Also during 1000 Miglia 2021 a strict protocol will be activated for the protection of the safety and health of those who will take part, for any reason, in the event has been developed.

Access to the controlled access spaces (Protected Areas) such as the Paddock, the Village and the Departure and Arrival area, have been numerically reduced to about 1/3 of the usual accommodation and while guaranteeing sufficient capacity for the regular performance of the various activities, entry will only be permitted following strict controls and checks provided for by the Sports Federation's provisions and in compliance with the limits of capacity imposed.

Collecting the Pass will be preceded by a pre-accreditation system, which is necessary to allow the tracking of every person who will pass through the controlled areas and which will be carried out in special spaces.

ACCESS TO PROTECTED AREAS

- People counting portals will be positioned at the entrance of each area of the event for real-time counting of incoming and outgoing flows: in no protected area will the number of accesses allowed at the same time be exceeded; security operators, hostesses and stewards will have the task of verifying body temperature remotely, checking the correct use of the Personal Protective Equipment, observance of interpersonal distance and hand sanitizing.
- Specific Covid Managers and a Team 1000 Miglia have been identified who, in the event of body temperature exceeding 37.5°, will provide assistance and activate current health and safety procedures. In case of body temperature exceeding 37.5°, access to the Protected Area will not be allowed and the person will be hosted in a reserved area.

CHECKS ALONG THE RACE ROUTE

- Procedures for temperature checking, observance of interpersonal distance, the correct use of Personal Protective Equipment and hand sanitizing will be activated at the Start and Arrival Time Control points of each leg in the rooms and facilities reserved for the lunches and dinners on the race days (16th, 17th, 18th and 19th June).
- Crews made up of people not living together must also wear the mask on board the race car.
- Should body temperature exceed 37.5°, during the entire course of the event the Covid Managers and Team 1000 Miglia will carry out an assistance service and activate the procedures in force regarding safety and health by hosting the person in a reserved area.
- In the event of the body temperature of only one crew member exceeding 37.5° during the race, the safety and health procedures in force will be automatically applied to both members of the crew.
