



The City of 1000 Miglia

Brescia, the Lioness of Italy, is remembered and known as the city in which the most beautiful race in the world originates.

The Green Talk will be held at Palazzo Loggia in Brescia during the day of Friday 27th September, while Piazza Paolo VI will come to life at the 1000 Miglia Green Paddock where the technical checks will take place. The participants will have the chance to walk through the most beautiful streets of the city centre on the evening of the 1st Leg.





Crespi d'Adda

Workers' Village of Crespi D'Adda

On Saturday 28th, the lunch at Crespi D'Adda will be a tribute to the spirit that accompanied the birth of modern Italian Industry.

The Workers' Village of Crespi became part of UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2005. It is one of the best preserved examples of an industrial workers' village in the world. Unlike similar sites, the plant was operational until December 2003 and the houses are still inhabited.






Piazza Gae Aulenti, Milan

Designed by Cesar Peli and named after the great designer and architect Gae Aulenti, the square was inaugurated in 2012, coming within one of Europe's largest and most important urban redevelopment projects: the new smart district of Porta Nuova.


Alice Ristorante

Dinner on Saturday will be held at Alice.






Cernusco sul Naviglio

The cycle path along the Naviglio Martesana

During the third and final leg, on Saturday 28th, the convoy will travel along a section of the cycle path towards the centre of Milan.

The cycle path along the Alzaia Naviglio Martesana allows you to reach Milan directly and in the opposite direction Trezzo d'Adda, for a total journey of over 30 km along the Naviglio.

Once a navigable river, it now flows along many kilometres of cycle paths that link the city's various parks and create an increasingly dense green network.





The ACI SARA Safe Driving Centre in Lainate

Advanced track tests

The ACI-SARA Safe Driving Centre, located on the outskirts of Milan, was completely reconsidered and enhanced at exactly the same time as EXPO 2015, recalling the splendour of the Italian automotive Industry. On Sunday 29th, the cars taking part in the race will have the possibility to do their time trials along the 1,500 metres of the circuit at the end of the sporting activity foreseen by the program.

An avant-garde construction, the ACI-SARA Safe Driving Centre uses the most modern technology with the aim to teach the correct driving techniques to thousands of people a year, even in critical and emergency situations.

The lunch and the prize-giving ceremony will be held on the terrace with a 360 degree view of the circuit.


