1000 Miglia Warm Up USA 2022 will take place in and around Middleburg, Virginia and Washington, D.C. from 18 to 23 October.

After a first day dedicated to training on the techniques that characterize regularity races, the second edition of the Coppa USA, a competition of over 500 miles in true 1000 Miglia style, will get underway, finishing at the Embassy of Italy in Washington, D.C.

The winner of the group at the end of the training day will receive the Micro 1000 Miglia Trophy.

Chopard, World Sponsor and Official Timekeeper, will award the winning crew with a couple of exclusive watches

The winner of the 1 vs 1 challenge will receive the Middleburg Trophy.

The overall winner of the second edition of the 1000 Miglia Warm Up USA 2022 will receive the Coppa USA. Chopard, World Sponsor and Official Timekeeper, will award the winning crew with a couple of exclusive watches

The right of acceptance to the 1000 Miglia 2023 is at stake (after entering in compliance with the Race Regulations) for the first and second classified Veteran 1000 Miglia Era category, for the first and second classified Novice 1000 Miglia Era category, for the first classified Veteran and Novice Post 1000 Miglia Era category.

Together with Chopard, the Embassy of Italy, Vredestein Tyres, the Town of Middleburg, Salamander Resort & Spa and Creighton Farms are supporting the event.

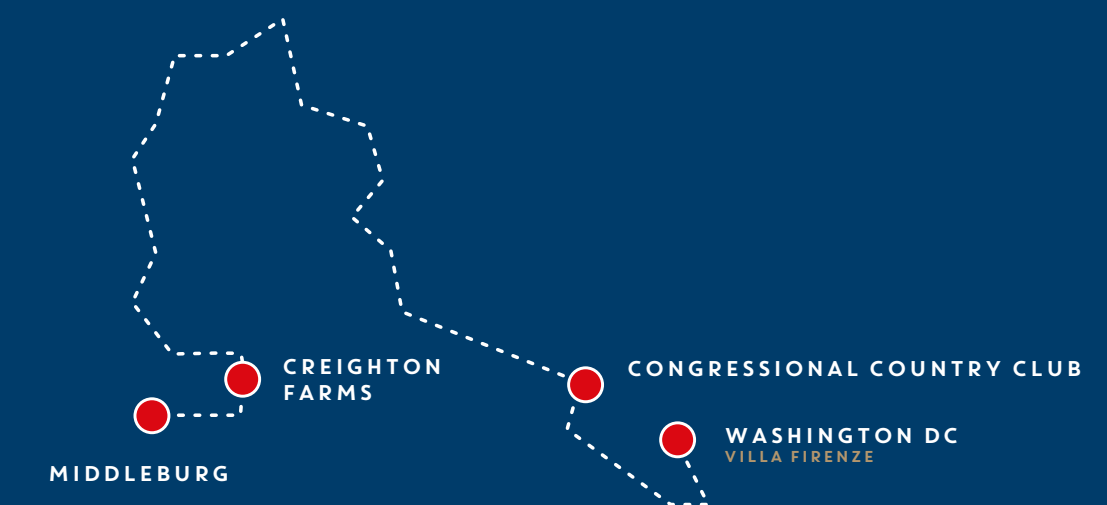

## CLASSES OF COMPETITORS

An event designed for experienced and novice participants

### Veteran Crew

A crew is defined as VETERAN if at least one of the two drivers entered has taken part in at least two editions of the 1000 Miglia within the last 10 years (2013 to 2022).

### Novice Crew

A crew is defined as NOVICE if both drivers entered have taken part in at most one edition of the 1000 Miglia within the last 10 years (2013 to 2022).

## 1000 Miglia Era Car Class 1927 – 1957

- Cars with models that took part in the 1000 Miglia Speed Race held between 1927 and 1957.
- Cars produced before 1957 that, at the discretion of the organization, are of high historical and/or sporting interest, even though they have not been entered in the 1000 Miglia Speed Race.







## Post-1000 Miglia Era Car Class 1958 – Present

- Sport and Grand Touring cars built from 1958 to the present such as Alfa Romeo, Ferrari, Mercedes, Ford (GT40), Maserati, BMW, Jaguar, Lamborghini, Aston Martin, Porsche, AC, Chevrolet (Corvette), etc.

The cars must be in their original configuration, i.e., that provided by the manufacturer for normal road use.

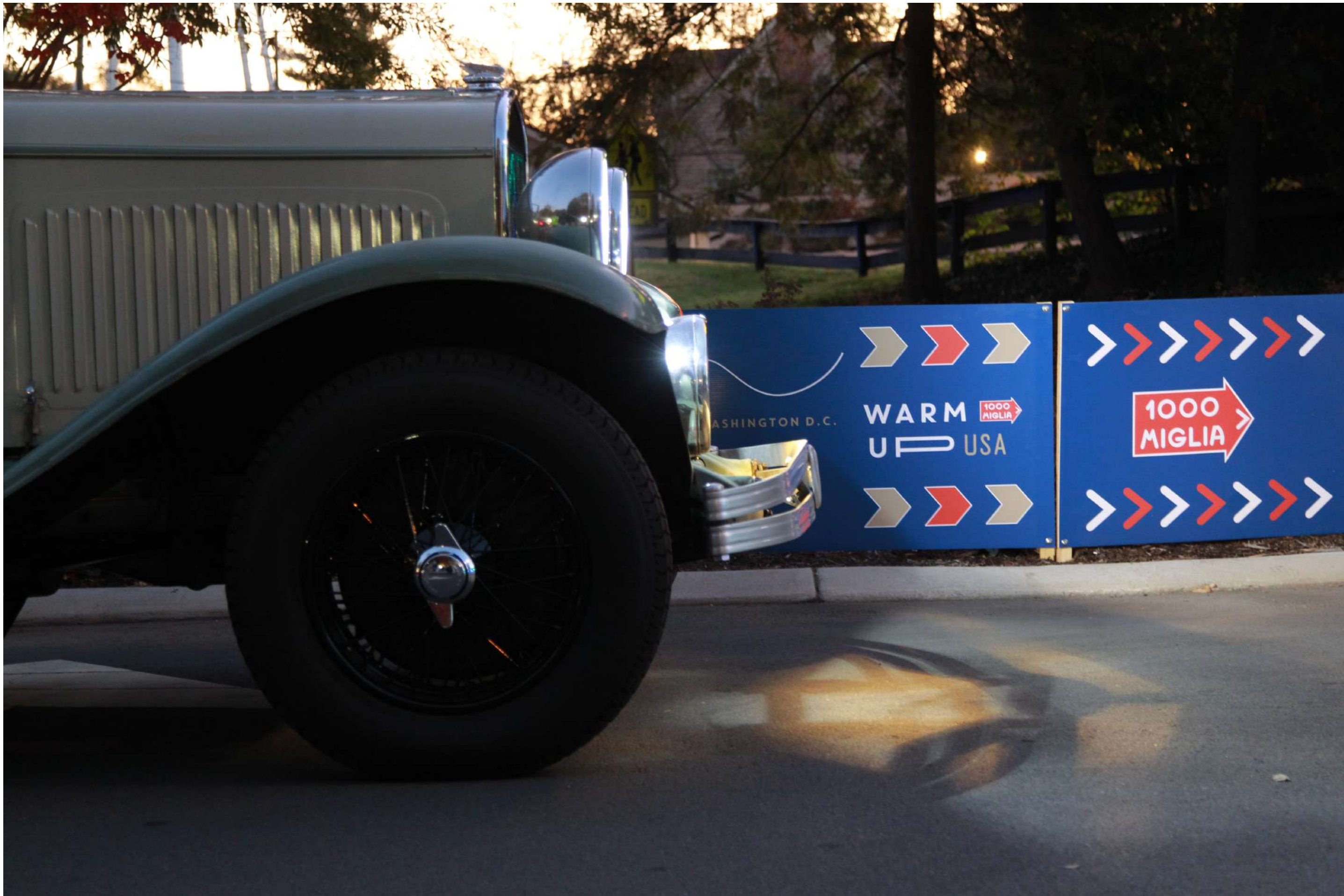

## **SUMMIT POINT MOTORSPORT PARK**

### **WEST VIRGINIA**

Summit Point Motorsports Park will host, in addition to the regularity race training day, part of the time trials to be held on the following days, as per the pending schedule.

Opened in 1969, the track celebrates its 50th anniversary this year and, for many, many years, was the site of both SCCA (Sports Car Club of America) and IMSA races. Since the 1980s, the facility has been used extensively as a training ground for federal government agencies, and in 1996 and 2004, two additional road courses, Jefferson and Shenandoah, were added to the property. The annual Jefferson 500 race is one of the most popular events on the circuit, which today attracts competitions of the magnitude of more than 200 vintage race cars.





## CONGRESSIONAL COUNTRY CLUB BETHESDA, MARYLAND

A famous club where members of Congress meet with businessmen, the Congressional Country Club opened in 1924 and, home to three U.S. Opens, has hosted the world's greatest golfing champions on the course. Past members include U.S. Presidents Taft, Wilson, Harding, Coolidge and Hoover, as well as countless politicians, lobbyists and major industrialists. It has been voted the best country club in the United States and is listed among the 25 most prestigious clubs in the world.





## **EMBASSY OF ITALY IN WASHINGTON, D.C.**

### **ARRIVAL ON ITALIAN SOIL**

Built in 2000, the building stands in one of Washington's most important urban areas, the so-called Embassy Row, where many other foreign embassies and diplomatic residences are located.

The design is inspired by the floor plan of Washington, created in the late 18th century: in fact, the building's quadrangular plan reflects the original 100-square-mile plan that was envisioned for the U.S. capital, and just as the Potomac River divided the original area of the District of Columbia between Virginia and Maryland, the Italian Chancery is crossed by a diagonal gap that divides it into two equal parts.
