

FAQ SPORTING LICENCES

Drivers must be in possession of the following documents in order to carry out the administrative checks. All files can be uploaded in the reserved area by 20 May and the originals must be brought to the Paddock.

ITALIAN DRIVERS

- \rightarrow Identity document (front and back) valid for the entire duration of the race;
- → **Driving licence** (front and back) valid for the entire duration of the event;
- \rightarrow **Sports licence** valid for the entire duration of the race;
- → **Medical certificate** for non-competitive sporting activity stamped and signed by a doctor and valid, with indication of ECG date;
- \rightarrow Passport photo
- → Vehicle Registration certificate (front and back);
- → Any **declaration that the vehicle does not require a periodic inspection** according to the laws of the country where the vehicle is registered
- \rightarrow Vehicle insurance valid for the entire duration of the event;
- → **Document of historicity of the car** (Certificato Registro 1000 Miglia, FIVA ID...) in case the vehicle built before the 31.12.2003

FOREIGN DRIVERS

- \rightarrow Identity document (front and back) valid for the entire duration of the race;
- \rightarrow **Driving licence** (front and back) valid for the entire duration of the event;
- → Drivers with a non-EU national driving licence must be in possession of an **international driving licence** (front and back) valid in Italy;
- ightarrow International sports licence or national sports license with VISA issued by the NSA;
- \rightarrow Medical certificate for non-competitive sports activity. The document must be produced in English
- \rightarrow Passport photo
- \rightarrow Vehicle registration certificate (front and back);
- → Any **declaration that the vehicle does not require a periodic inspection** according to the laws of the country of registration of the car
- ightarrow Vehicle insurance valid on the date of the competition;
- → **Document of historicity** of the car (Certificato Registro 1000 Miglia, FIVA ID...) in case the vehicle built before the 31.12.2003

For drivers with foreign residence with no sports license, it is possible to apply for a temporary Italian licence. In order to make this request, besides the papers listed above, the following documents must be uploaded in the reserved area:

 \rightarrow Self-declaration of non-possession of other licences;

→ Authorization to 1000 Miglia Srl to request the document at the Automobile Club of Brescia. The temporary licence issuing service has a cost of \in 240 VAT included for each document requested.
