





The **challenge** is unique: to travel the entire route from Brescia to Rome and back, in a regularity race, managing recharges while respecting the set times and checkpoints, and finishing the parade for the public in Italy's most beautiful city centers.

The route of the **1000 Miglia Green 2023** starts and finishes in Brescia, and will follow the official route of the 41st re-enactment of the 1000 Miglia, passing through hundreds of Italy's most fascinating locations.

The route is divided into five legs. It includes a racing section and additional **free transfer** sectors to allow crews to manage **recharging** in complete autonomy

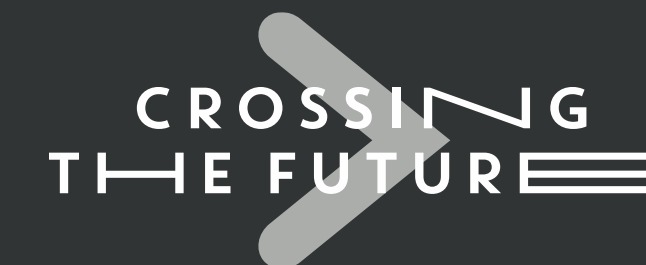

Approx. 160 km (full 1000 Miglia route)

Arrival in Cervia – Milano Marittima

Start from the Military Airport of Pisignano – Cervia

- Approx. 260 Km

Lunch in Macerata

- Free transfer to Rome

Approx. 300 km (full 1000 Miglia route)

Arrival in Rome, Villa Borghese and parade on the Platform in Via Veneto

Start from Rome, Parco de Medici

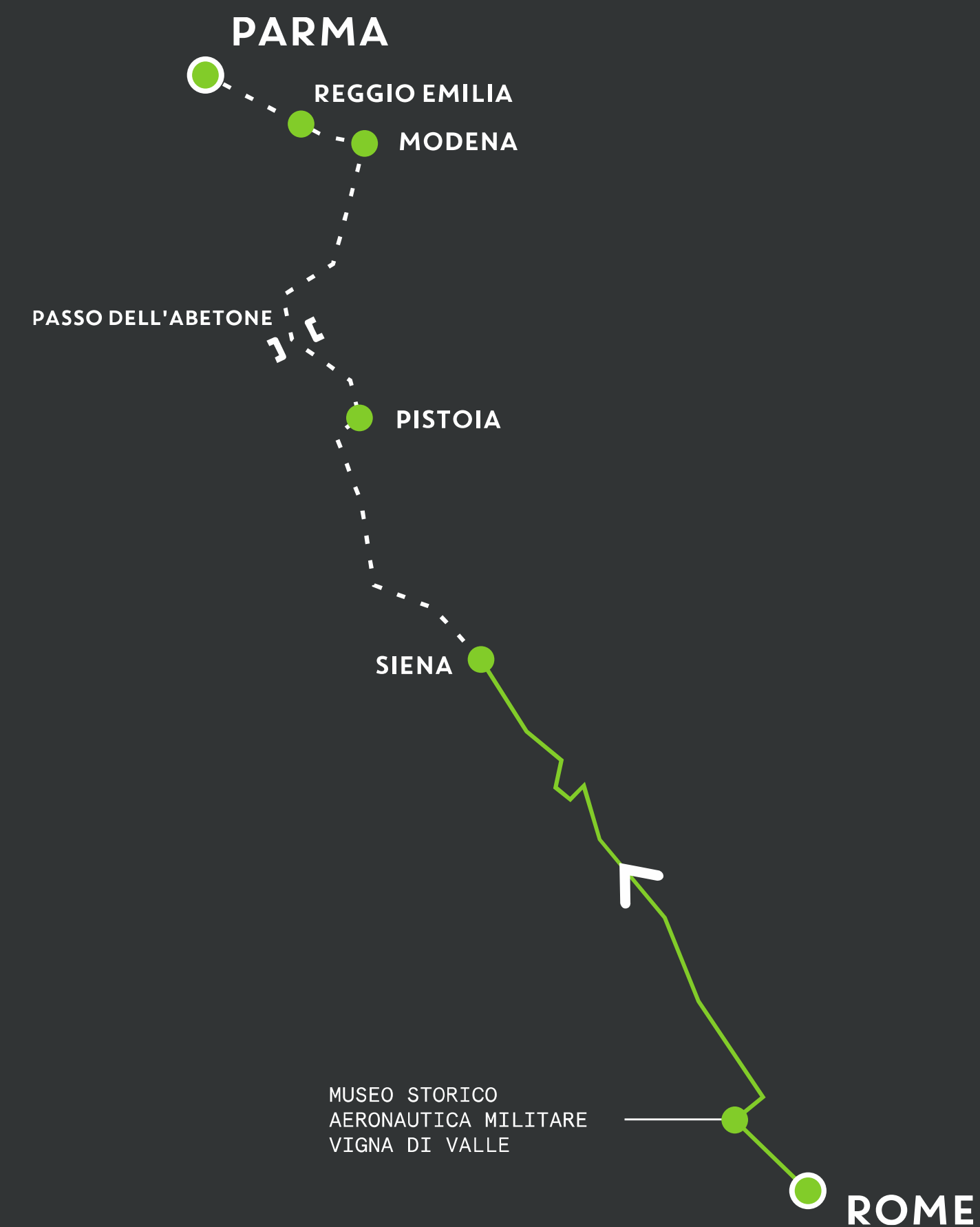
