The 1000 Miglia Green, an event reserved for Hypercars, Supercars and Premium Full-electric Brands, returns once again alongside the 1000 Miglia 2023, the World's Most Beautiful Race.

Crossing the future: cars built between 1927 and 1957, representing the ingenuity and technological innovation of their era, together with alternative fuel models which are the imminent future of mobility.





The challenge is unique: to travel the entire route from Brescia to Rome and back, in a regularity race, managing recharges while respecting the set times and checkpoints, and finishing the parade for the public in Italy's most beautiful city centers.





## THE ROUTE





The route of the 1000 Miglia Green 2023 starts and finishes in Brescia, and will follow the official route of the 41<sup>st</sup> reenactment of the 1000 Miglia, passing through hundreds of Italy's most fascinating locations.

The route is divided into five legs. It includes a racing section and additional free transfer sectors to allow crews to manage recharging in complete autonomy
