IL PEERCORSO THE ROUTE





Starting and finishing in Brescia, the route of the 1000 Miglia Green 2024 will follow the official route of the 42nd re-enactment of the 1000 Miglia, passing through hundreds of Italy's most fascinating locations.

Divided into 5 legs, the route includes a section of the race layout and additional free transfer sectors where the crews can handle recharging in complete autonomy





