THE ROUTE

The 2024 Edition will start from Brescia on **Tuesday 11 June** and will pass through **Bergamo** and **Novara** before arriving in **Turin** for the first leg finish.

On the second day, the convoy will start its descent southwards, passing through the Langhe region and through the centre of **Alba** before heading to **Genoa**, the absolute novelty of the **1000 Miglia 2024**, where the crews will stop for lunch. The race will end with the arrival in **Viareggio**.

The third leg will see the descent towards the Capital: initially the race will turn inland passing through **Lucca**, then return to the coast in **Livorno** until the lunch break in **Castiglione della Pescaia** before arriving in Via Veneto in **Rome**.

During the fourth leg, the crews will drive up to **Orvieto** and then **Solomeo**, the lunch venue. After the break it will be the turn of **Siena** with the arrival in the evening in **Bologna**.

On the final day of Saturday 15 June, the route will pass through **Ferrara** and **Mantua**, then **Lake Garda** with the **Valtenesi** and **Salò** and finish with the classic platform in Viale Venezia.
