VAL CAMONICA

The first of the Italian sites on the UNESCO World Heritage List, Val Camonica holds one of the largest collections of petroglyphs in the world. For this reason, it has become known as the «Valle dei Segni».

On its right side stands the Parco dell'Adamello, also recognised as a UNESCO Global Geopark thanks to its rare geological and morphological heritage. As well as being home to numerous wild animals, including brown bears, roe deer, chamois, golden eagles and white partridges, the park is also home to 1,300 species of plants and flowers.



COPPA DELLE ALPI LOCATIONS

TIRANO AND MIDDLE VALTELLINA

The twelve municipalities enclosed in the heart of the valley reflect the **traditions** of the people who have passed through and lived there over the years: numerous shrines, churches, palaces and historical sites make Tirano and Middle Valtellina an attractive and cultural destination.

In Tirano, it is also possible to board the famous **Bernina Red Train** for a journey through breathtaking views, blooming meadows and snow-capped peaks.



LIVIGNO

Embraced by the Rhaetian Alps, Livigno is a popular tourist destination for Italian and international visitors who each year choose to stay here, in summer and winter, and experience a holiday of sport, relaxation, tradition, shopping and typical food and wine.

The resort will host the Freestyle and Snowboard competitions scheduled for the 2026 Milano Cortina Olympics. 26 Olympic titles will be awarded in Livigno, crowning a long-standing relationship with both the Olympic Games and the specialities that will animate this eagerly awaited appointment with history.




ST. MORITZ

Home to two editions of the Olympic Games, St. Moritz is an ideal destination for winter sports enthusiasts, also thanks to the presence of the Cresta Run, the only natural bobsleigh run on ice in the world.

There are, however, numerous possibilities offered by the Engadin resort: the Mauritius thermal spring was discovered more than three thousand years ago and wellness continues to be one of the main features of St. Moritz.

In addition, the Alpine town has become a showcase for artists, trendsetters and car lovers. Carevents, in fact, have been a regular feature in this extraordinary location since the late 1920s.



VAL MÜSTAIR

The region offers a unique natural and cultural landscape, with large green spaces that are mostly home to **organically farmed** crops.

The valley is also known for the many forms of handicrafts, which are carried out in accordance with local traditions, oriented by the search for quality.

Amidst the meadows and mountains stands the jewel of the Val Müstair, the Abbey of St John, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that houses the largest and best-preserved series of frescoes from the early Middle Ages.



BRIXEN

The oldest town in the Tyrol, Brixen has enviable historical and architectural beauties such as the Cathedral square, the medieval old town, the arcades, the decorated narrow streets and museum treasures, not to mention its prestigious handicraft tradition.

Just 7 kilometres from the city centre is the Plose ski resort, with its 43 kilometres of slopes and breathtaking views of the Dolomites.



PONTE DI LEGNO

Thanks to the Presena glacier, it is possible to ski in Ponte di Legno as early as autumn. In winter, the **four ski areas** (Ponte di Legno, Passo Tonale, Presena Glacier and Temù) offer snow sports enthusiasts 41 slopes, ranging from 1121 to 3016 metres in altitude, served by 28 innovative ski lifts.

In summer, in addition to the possibility of discovering the art, culture and history preserved in these valleys, trekking, climbing, biking and walks also suitable for children are popular.
