St. Moritz, in the heart of the Engadin, will be the backdrop for the whole event.

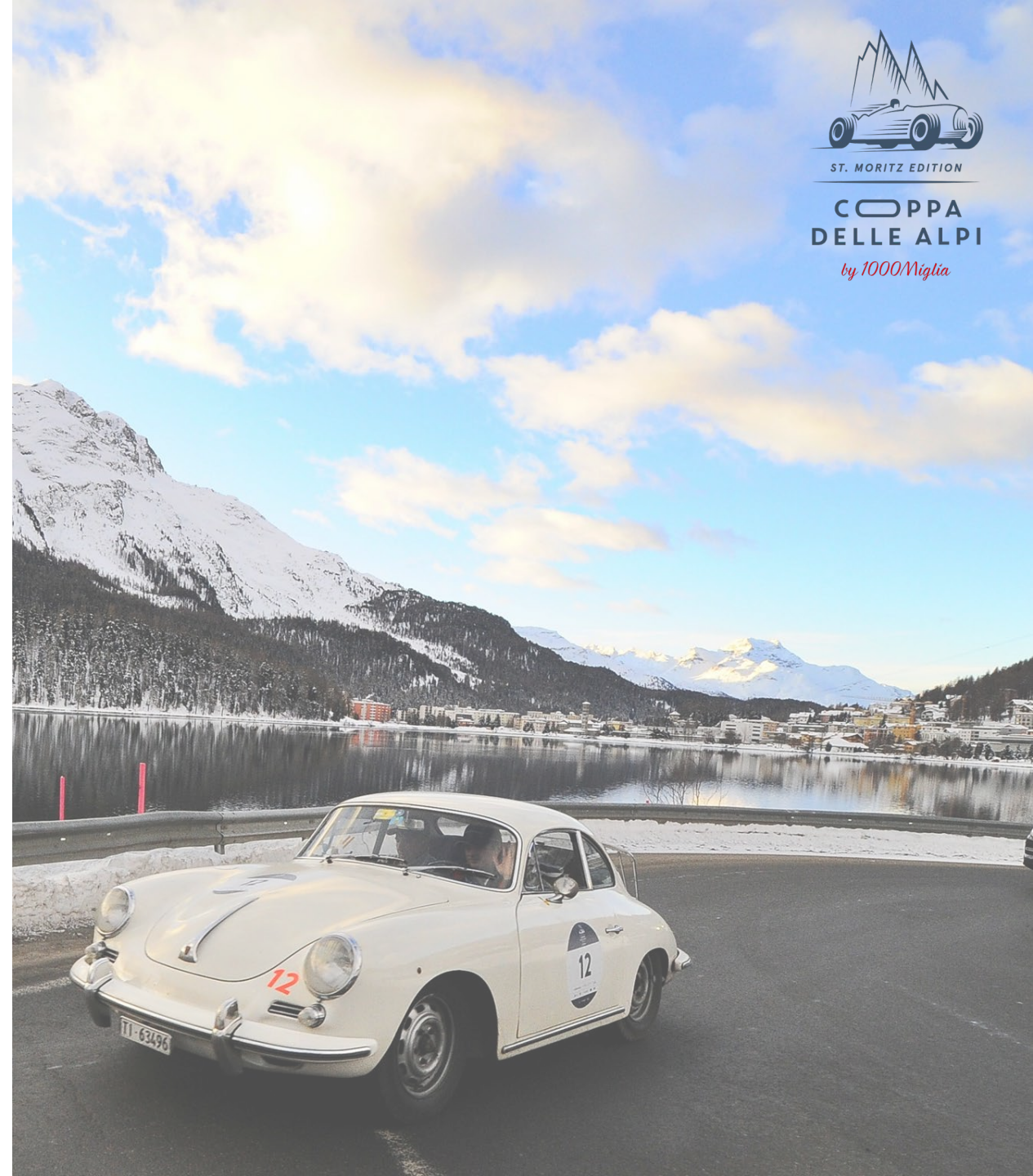
The participants will face about 90 Time Trials, spread over three days, on a technical and fascinating route that will test the crews' skills.

ST. MORITZ

The venue for **two Olympic Games**, St. Moritz is the ideal destination for winter sports enthusiasts, thanks in part to the Cresta Run, the only natural ice bobsleigh track in the world.

However, the Engadin region offers numerous possibilities: the **Mauritius thermal spring** was discovered over three thousand years ago and **wellness** continues to be one of the main features that characterise St. Moritz.

Furthermore, the Alpine town has become a showcase for **artists, trendsetters** and car enthusiasts. **Car events** have been a constant feature of this extraordinary location since the late 1920s.



LIVIGNO

Surrounded by the **Rhaetian Alps**, Livigno is a tourist destination loved by Italian and international visitors who choose to stay there every year, both in summer and in winter, where they can enjoy a holiday filled with sports, relaxation, traditions, shopping and typical food and wine.

The town will host the Freestyle and Snowboard races scheduled for the **2026 Milan-Cortina Olympics**. A total of **26 Olympic titles** will be awarded in Livigno, crowning a long-standing relationship with both the Olympic Games and the sports that will animate this highly anticipated appointment with History.



VAL MUSTAIR

The region offers a unique natural and cultural landscape, with large green spaces that are mostly used for **organic farming**.

The valley is also known for its many forms of **craftsmanship**, which are carried out in accordance with **local traditions** and guided by the pursuit of **quality**.

Amongst the meadows and mountains stands the jewel of Val Mustair, the **Monastery of St. John**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that houses the largest and best-preserved series of early medieval frescoes.



AROSA

The small mountain town of Arosa is one of the gems of the Canton of Graubünden, framed by the peaks of the south-eastern side of the Weisshorn range.

A traditional holiday resort much loved by winter sports enthusiasts and those who prefer hiking along alpine trails and downhill biking in the summer months, Arosa has been a tourist resort since 1877. It is located in the scenic **Schanfigg Valley**, at an altitude of about 1,800 metres, and is surrounded by 400 beautiful high peaks.



POWER STAGE

During the event, there will be a Power Stage that will award extra points for the championship.

Carrying out the Power Stage is mandatory for all the participants entered in the race and will consist of three timed sections measured to the nearest hundredth of a second (called SPLIT 1-2-3), linked together.



ACCEPTED CARS

- The accepted cars will be divided into the following CATEGORIES:
- Group RC1 cars belonging solely to Classification Periods of Time A, B, C (built up to 1930)
- Group RC2 cars belonging solely to Classification Periods of Time D, E (built from 1931 to 1950)
- Group RC3 cars belonging only to Classification Periods of Time E, F, G (built from 1951 to 1965)
- Group RC4 cars belonging only to Classification Periods of Time G, H, I (built from 1966 to 1981)
- Group RC5 cars belonging only to Classification Periods of Time J1, J2 (built from 1982 to 1992)
- Group RC6 cars belonging only to Classification Periods of Time K (built from 1993 to 2000)

PRIZES

- First 5 crews in the Overall Classification
- First 3 crews in the Category Classifications
- First 3 crews in the Average Trial Classifications
- First Team
- First Female Crew
- First Crew Under 30
- For the crew with the lowest number of net MVP penalties

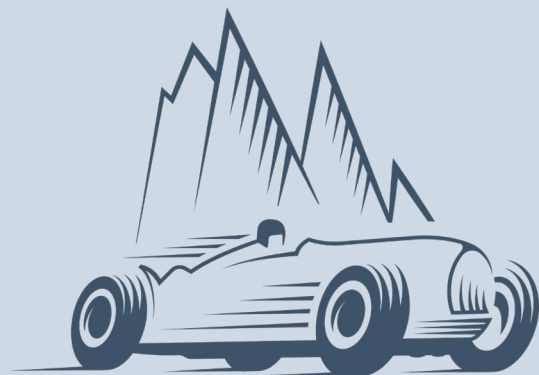
