

1000 MIGLIA 2026 ACCREDITATION REGULATIONS

HOW TO APPLY FOR ACCREDITATION

Applications for accreditation to 1000 Miglia 2026 (the "Event") must be submitted **exclusively online** in accordance with the procedure set out in these regulations, **no later than 3 June 2026**. Requests received by other means will not be considered. It will not be possible to obtain accreditation on site.

ONLINE PROCEDURE

The procedures for obtaining accreditation are as follows.

- 1. RECEIPT OF VOUCHER:** the user will receive a voucher with a web address and an alphanumeric code to be entered in the appropriate section of the portal www.accrediti1000miglia.it
- 2. ENTERING PERSONAL DATA:** in the appropriate sections of the above page, the user must enter the personal data (name, surname, place and date of birth, nationality, residence, mobile phone number and email address) necessary for accreditation.
Please note that the mobile phone number and email address provided must be strictly personal and available to allow 1000 Miglia to contact you.
Registration to the portal must be made only once.
- 3. ACCEPTANCE OF DOCUMENTATION:** the user must accept the following documentation by ticking the appropriate box:
 - These "Accreditation Regulations"
 - Image release
 - Privacy Policy.Authorisation to process personal data for commercial purposes is optional.
- 4. RECEIPT OF E-MAIL CONFIRMING ACCREDITATION REQUEST:** the user will receive an e-mail confirming the accreditation request at the e-mail address provided when entering their personal details, with instructions on how to collect the pass.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Acceptance of the accreditation request is entirely at the discretion of 1000 Miglia S.r.l.;
- Incomplete requests, requests that do not comply with these regulations or requests received after the deadline will not be accepted.
- Please check your spam folder for confirmation emails.
- A valid identity document must be presented when collecting the pass.
- The pass holder or the person who collected it on behalf of the accredited person is liable for the loss thereof and for any damage that prevents the use of the same. 1000 Miglia S.r.l. is not obliged to issue a new pass; any replacement will be at the sole discretion of 1000 Miglia S.r.l.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO ACCESS TO THE EVENT AREAS

By applying for accreditation, you declare:

1. that you are aware of the dangers inherent in motor racing events and in attending them. You also certify that you have the experience and professional training to safely attend the event and that you will take all necessary precautions to avoid physical injury and damage to yourself and others;
2. that you are aware that the event takes place on roads open to traffic and that you will therefore comply with all traffic regulations set out in the Italian Highway Code;
3. that you will comply at all times with:

- i) the instructions provided by 1000 Miglia and to conduct themselves in accordance with these instructions;
- ii) the safety orders and instructions provided by the Race Officials and the Police;
4. to accept all responsibility for any damage they may suffer as a result of their own negligence or inexperience;
5. to release 1000 Miglia, the Clerk of the Course, Automobile Club Brescia and any other person, institution or association for the above;
6. to release 1000 Miglia S.r.l. and all persons and companies involved in the organisation of the race, the ACI (Italian Automobile Club) in any way involved in the race, the Race Officials and the owners of the routes where the race takes place from any liability for any damage incurred by the pass holder or caused by third parties or things to the pass holder;
7. to be aware that the accreditation and, consequently, any pass provided are strictly personal and non-transferable, and to be aware that it is strictly forbidden to transfer it to third parties.
8. to be aware of and undertake to comply with any technical/health provisions and procedures that may be established from time to time by current legislation, the Competent Authorities, ACI Sport or 1000 Miglia S.r.l.;
9. that access to the Event Areas will be subject to compliance with any technical/health protocols in force and in relation to the maximum capacity available.

With regard to the use of images, the user also declares:

1. to authorise 1000 Miglia S.r.l. and/or the natural or legal persons appointed by the same to take photographs and make audio-video recordings of the user within the general context of the Event. Each user declares that they transfer and assign to 1000 Miglia S.r.l., free of charge, the rights to use the photos and/or audio-video recordings that 1000 Miglia S.r.l. and/or its agents will make in the context of the Event.
2. To authorise 1000 Miglia S.r.l. to store, commercially exploit and transfer to third parties the photos and/or audio-video recordings, as well as to disseminate them, including by re-editing them at its discretion, through editorial products (including, but not limited to: newspapers, books, magazines, etc.) and/or any type, method, means and system of use currently known (including, but not limited to: TV – terrestrial, satellite, cable; radio; internet – downloading, streaming; analogue and/or digital systems; social media, etc.) or that will become available in the future due to technological developments, without any territorial or transfer restrictions, including through total or partial transfer to third parties.
3. To indemnify 1000 Miglia S.r.l. from any claims by third parties relating to the above-mentioned photos and/or audio-video recordings.

Please note that the pass remains the property of 1000 Miglia. Any abuse, including the affixing of writing and stickers that have not been previously agreed with 1000 Miglia S.r.l., will result in the immediate withdrawal of the pass and may prevent its issue for subsequent years and, if necessary, the actions may be reported to the competent judicial authorities.

ACCREDITATION OF MINORS

In the case of accreditation of minors, the procedure set out in these regulations must be followed. Declarations relating to minors must be issued and signed by an adult with parental authority, who will be the only person authorised to collect the minor's pass. Minors may only access the areas involved in the Event if accompanied by an adult who accepts responsibility and custody for them.

PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The processing of personal data collected during the accreditation procedures will be carried out in accordance with EU Regulation no. 2016/679 (the GDPR) and Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, as amended by Italian Legislative Decree no. 101/2018. For details on the processing of personal data, please refer to the specific "Privacy Policy" pursuant to Art. 13 of the GDPR.
