CLASSIC CAR TOURISM REGULARITY 2026

These Supplementary Race Regulations (SRR) are drawn up in accordance with the International Sporting Code, the National Sporting Regulations, and other provisions of the ACI Sporting Federation under which the following articles shall be understood to govern.

For the purposes of approval and issuance of the organization permit, these SRR electronically filled in in all the parts and signed by the Organizer, the Regional Delegate and the Event Manager, must be entered within the deadlines indicated in the RSN in the appropriate section within the Reserved Area of the ACI Sport website.

Regulations that have not been drawn up using this model will not be accepted for the purpose of issuing an organizing permit. The Organizer declares that the race has the necessary administrative permits and insurance coverage.

The above cars are not required to have the documents (ACI-Sport identity, HTP FIA, etc.) provided for participation in Classic Car regularity events.

Only competitors, drivers and their cars accepted for the "1000 Miglia 2026" race, competitors, drivers and their cars accepted for the "Ferrari Tribute 1000 Miglia 2026" race, and competitors, drivers and their cars accepted for the "1000 Miglia Experience Gran Turismo 2026" race will be accepted to participate in the "9th Roberto Gaburri Trophy" race.

Accepted cars will be categorized in the relevant period according to the year of production.

Up to 100 cars will be accepted for the race, of which 35 will be modern.

Cars with "test plates" will not be accepted.

ARTICLE 3 - ROUTE

Entries will be to be submitted through the management system prepared by 1000 Miglia S.r.l. on the website www.1000miglia.it.

Competitors and their drivers accepted to the "1000 Miglia 2026", "Ferrari Tribute 1000 Miglia 2026" and "1000 Miglia Experience Gran Turismo 2026" races will be invited to participate in the entry phase.

The system will only allow the first 100 users already entered in the "1000 Miglia 2026", "Ferrari Tribute 1000 Miglia 2026" and "1000 Miglia Experience Gran Turismo 2026" to finalize their entry for the "9th Roberto Gaburri Trophy 2026"; once this limit has been reached, the system will not accept further entry requests.

The Organizer, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to select from the entries received a maximum number of cars not exceeding 100.

There is no entry fee.

Entries will be open and closed on the days and times indicated in the race programme.

ARTICLE 7 - THE PROCESS - MAXIMUM TIME

At 6:30 pm on Sunday, June 7th, 2026, the competitors will start, according to the starting order determined by the time of entry into the queuing area, from Piazza Vittoria in Brescia on their way to the Time Trials, according to the attached map and the Road Book provided by the organization.

The cars will start one at a time, from a stationary position and with the engine running.

After passing the final TC, the race will be over and the cars will be free to return to the paddock area at the Brixia

Forum in via Caprera - Brescia, by 8:00 pm.

At the TCs, under the control of the Officials, the start may also be allowed by pushing, in case the car is unable to start under its own power.

The cars will start in each TT series concatenated one at a time, from a stationary position and with the engine running, with a maximum frequency of two cars per minute. Each car, upon receiving the start, must clear the starting space in the shortest possible time.

A crew will be considered out of maximum time:

- If it transits at a Time Control more than **15 minutes late**.
- if it accumulates delays at multiple checks altogether exceeding **30 minutes per race day**.

ARTICLE 9 - CLASSIFICATIONS

The following classifications will be compiled:

a) General;	b) Of grouping;
c) Female Crews;	d) Average Trials (if any);
e) general without coefficients	

Classifications must be compiled without discards under RDS Regularity, time checks per race day max 1.

No coefficients will be applied.

ARTICLE 10 - PRIZES

The prizes shown are the minimum prizes to be provided by the Organizer. Larger quantities are optional. The competition will have the following honour prizes:

- for the top 5 crews in the overall classification;
-for the top 3 crews in the GROUP classifications;
-for the first ranked team;
-for the first female crew;
-for the top 3 crews in the average speed test classification (if applicable);
-for the winner(s) of the special classifications (if applicable).

The classification will be drawn up without any discard on penalties accumulated in the race and in accordance Article 13 RDS Regularity. The prizes of the overall, grouping and priority driver classifications are not cumulative with each other, therefore, the winners of more than one classification will be awarded only the prize of the most relevant classification.

ARTICLE 11 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

By entering the race, each competitor declares for himself and his drivers, co-drivers, employees and appointees:

- To accept and abide by the National Sporting Regulations, Supplementary Rules and the Race Rules;
- to undertake to settle any dispute, which may arise due to facts arising from the Organization and the conduct of the race, by means of the mechanisms and methods of solution arranged by the ACI, renouncing to appeal to any authority other than the sports authorities for the protection of its rights and interests and those of its drivers, co-drivers, employees and appointees;
- to hold relieved the Automobile Club of Italy, the Organizer and all persons in charge of the organization, the

Automobile Clubs however involved in the race, the Officials and the owners of the courses where the race takes place, from any liability regarding any damage occurred to it, its drivers, co-drivers, employees and appointees or things, or produced or caused to third parties or things by it, its drivers, co-drivers, employees and appointees.

✓	PENALTY TABLE AND OTHER DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Article 13 - INSURANCE

The Organizer, as a sports licence holder, from the moment of its signing adheres to the current sports regulations. In this context, it confirms that it has full knowledge that the liability policy, mentioned in Article 56 of the RSN, responds to the canons provided for in Article 124 of the Insurance Code, with the legal minimums, and does not relieve the Competitors and Conductors from any liability they may possibly incur outside the object of the insurance and additional general and special policy conditions as published on the federal website and in any case obtainable from the Insurance Company.

Art. 14 - RACE NUMBER PLATES.


14.1 All Race Numbers (Plates) delivered by the Organizer to the Competitor, must be applied to the Race Car. The finding of the presence of one of the plates of the Race Numbers delivered on a vehicle other than the Race Car will result in a penalty up to and including the immediate exclusion of the Race Car from the Race.

The Organizer declares that it has **made changes to the Supplementary Regulations prepared by the ACI; each change has been highlighted in red-coloured font.** It also declares its commitment to verify that all those who will participate in the conduct of the race but who do not appear on these SRR will still hold a valid sports licence issued by the Federation. However, the holding of the race is subject to the issuance clearance from the relevant Ministry of Transport General Directorate for Road Safety as stipulated in Paragraph 3 Article 9 of the New Highway Code.

The measure approving these Supplementary Race Regulations shall be revoked ex officio, also in accordance with L.241-90, if the organizer fails to produce, within the terms and procedures stipulated by the ACI Federation's sports regulations, the compulsory insurance policy required by Article 124 of the Private Insurance Code, which constitutes an essential element of the authorization to hold races and sports competitions of any kind involving motor vehicles and the related trials.

ANNEX 1: Penalty Table.

PENALTIES AND OTHER DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Time Controls

- For each minute or fraction thereof early: 100 penalties
- For each minute or fraction thereof late: 100 penalties (with a maximum of 300)
- For each delay beyond the maximum time: exclusion

Time Trials

- For every 1/100th of a second early or late: 1 penalty (with a maximum of 300)

Time Card

- alteration, tampering, or corrections not endorsed by the U.G.: exclusion
- Failure to record at a time check: exclusion
- failure to return at time controls: exclusion
- Lack of a passage control stamp (passage control): exclusion

Other penalties

- For refusal to start at the appointed time and order: 100 penalties
- For stopping the car in the control zone (car stop): 100 penalties
- For unauthorized crew access to area of control (subject to further action): 300 penalties
- For failure to transit at any control: exclusion
- For unauthorized parking in the control area: exclusion
- for blocking passage and/or damage to other crews: exclusion
- for unsportsmanlike conduct: from warning to exclusion
- for transit at a control in the opposite or different direction: exclusion
- For traffic violations: up to exclusion
- For irregularity of documents during checks: non-acceptance
- For failure to meet the checking times: non- acceptance
- for being more than 15 minutes late to the start: non- acceptance
- For having the car driven by a person other than the driver or by the co-driver: exclusion
- For lack of a race number or race plate: fine
- for missing two or all of the race numbers: exclusion
- For failure to notify the Clerk of the Course of withdrawal: fine
- For failure to comply with the provisions relating to the synchronization of stopwatches: exclusion
- For careless behaviour of a driver or a co-driver: up to exclusion
- For leaning out of the moving car: up to exclusion
- For any specious or unsubstantiated time verification request: up to exclusion
- for irregularities in the car: up to exclusion
